Student Quarantine Guidance



Proper Masking

Improper Masking



No quarantine needed.
Monitor for symptoms x10 days and seek testing if symptoms develop.
CDC recommends testing on day 5 after exposure.

No quarantine is needed with daily testing OR
Quarantine for 5 days after exposure return on day 6 if no symptoms and a negative test from day 5 or the morning of day 6.
⚠️ A positive test will initiate an isolation period.
CDC recommends testing on day 5 after exposure.

No quarantine needed.
Monitor for symptoms x10 days and seek testing if symptoms develop.
CDC recommends testing on day 5 after exposure.

Quarantine for 5 days after exposure return on day 6 if no symptoms and a negative test from day 5 or the morning of day 6.

Not fully vaccinated and exposure as part of a cluster/outbreak

The school will work with the health department on the scope of the outbreak.
Quarantine for 5 days after exposure return on day 6 if no symptoms and a negative test from day 5 or the morning of day 6.
CDC recommends testing on day 5 after exposure.



"Fully Vaccinated" definition for use with this guidance:

- 14 days after completion of primary series of two shots of mRNA or single dose of J&J
- Or the above and a completed booster dose of mRNA vaccine



A positive case would need to isolate for 7 days returning on day 8. Returning student needs to be fever free for 24hrs or more.
